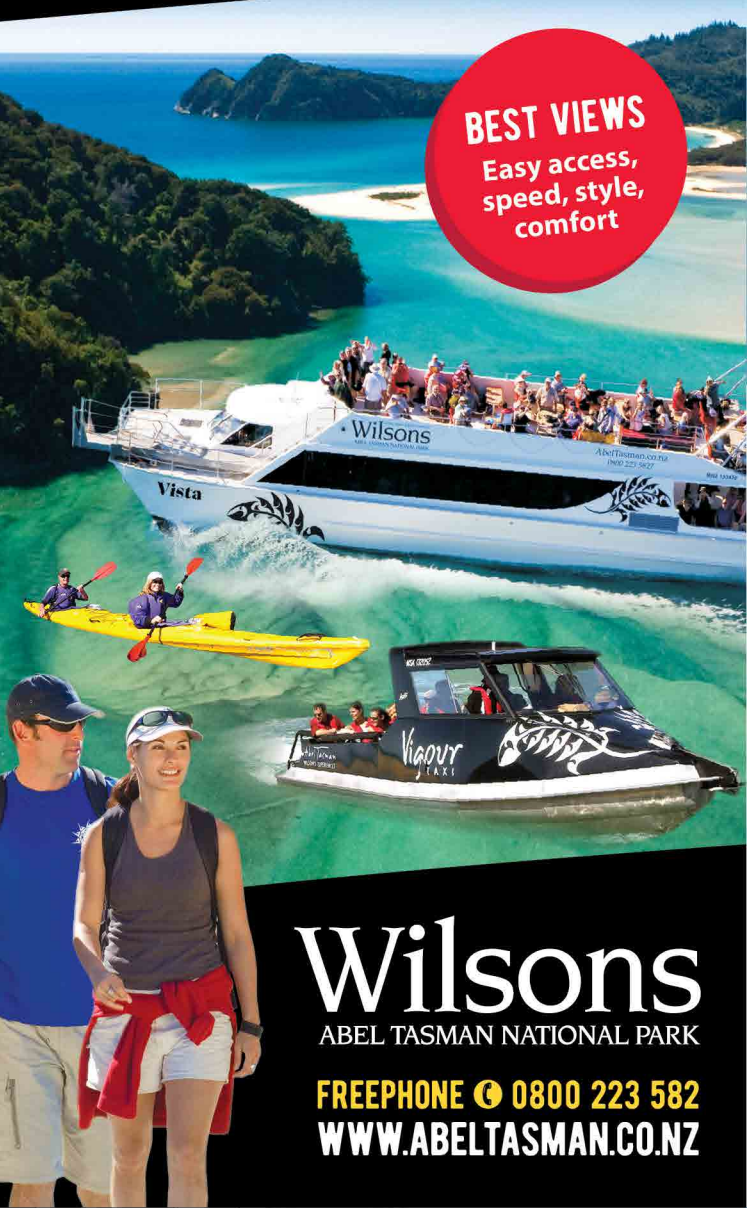

Terms and Cancellation Conditions:
We understand plans change. To be fair to everyone we detail our terms.

We appreciate your custom and aspire to provide a friendly and safe experience. All activities including those in which you have booked to engage do carry a degree of risk and by participating in the activities provided by the Operator you are assuming those risks personally and to the maximum extent permitted by law you release the Operator and its officers and employees from any liability, claims losses damages or expenses caused by any event including but not limited to:

- Personal injury or death;
- Property loss or damage;
- Acts which may be construed as negligent or accidental;
- Any other loss, damage, suffering, emotional or nervous disorder.

Standard Fares - Cancellations:

- Up to 7 days before departure: rebooking at no extra cost or full refund.
- 7 days to 24 hours before departure: rebooking at no extra cost or 50% refund.
- Within 24 to 0 hours of departure time: NO REFUND.
- After departure time: NO REFUND.

3 Day Pass (unlimited boat travel) - Conditions:

- No refund will be made on or after the first date of travel.
- Not transferable. Signature of client required for validation on the first day of travel.
- Valid for 3 days unlimited Vista travel within a 7 day period, from the first date of travel.

One Day Guided Kayak Trip - Cancellation conditions:

(a) If a customer chooses to cancel

- Up to 7 days before departure: rebooking at no extra cost or full refund.
- 7 days to 48 hours before departure: rebooking at no extra charge or 50% refund.
- Within 48 to 0 hours prior to or after departure time: NO REFUND.

(b) Cancellation by the guide

8.30am your kayak guide will assess weather conditions and decide if the trip will go ahead. On cancellation, kayakers will have the following choices:

- Cancel the day's outing for a full refund less any lunch costs; or
- Choose a cruise or cruise and walk option (without a guide) from the operators available services. You will be refunded the cost of the kayak trip less the price of the alternative trip chosen and any lunch costs.

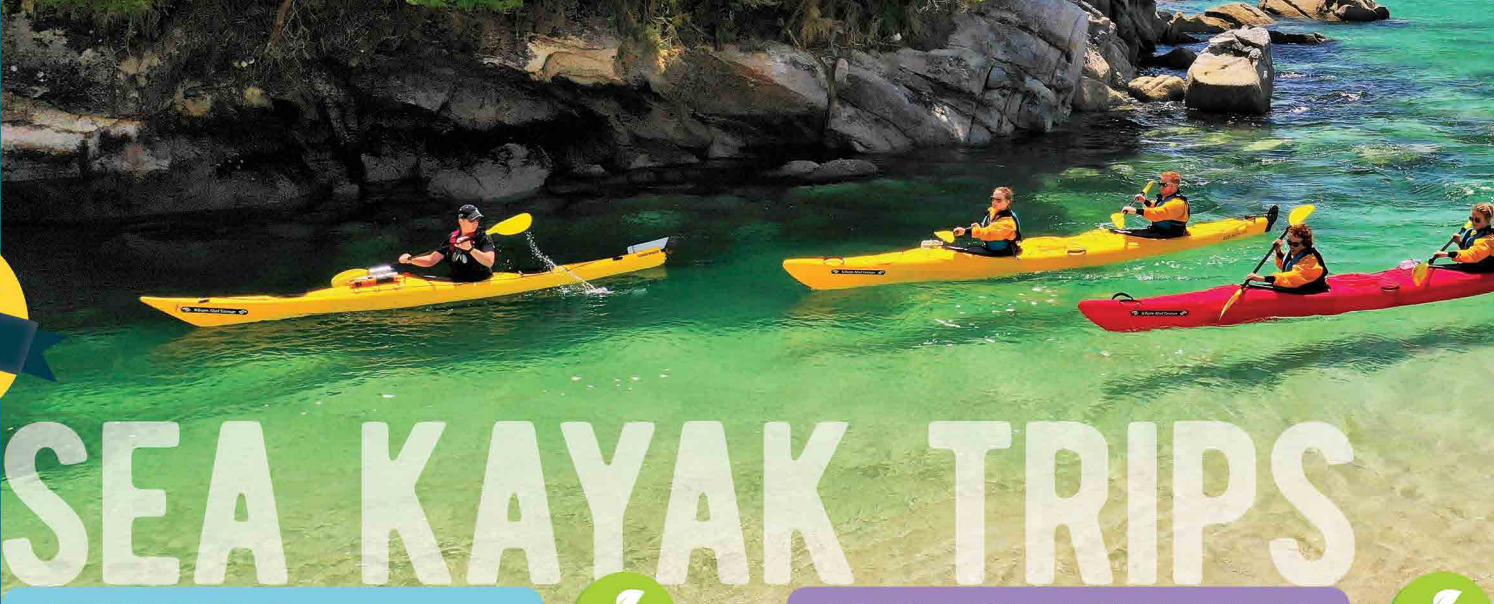
